We will organize the conference in a **HYBRID FORMAT** that allows **either residential or online presentation**, so please do not hesitate to submit your work.

This meeting, jointly organized by the [International Society for the Advancement of Financial Economics](#) (ISAFE), [Swansea University](#), and the [Association of Vietnamese Scientists and Experts](#) (AVSE Global), aims to bring together academics, practitioners, and policymakers to share their research findings and discuss current and challenging issues in financial economics.
